
WHAT TO EXPECT

Green Star Movement's volunteer program provides fun, meaningful opportunities to build teamwork skills while working with a great staff of teaching artists and students to design and install murals.








Green Star Movement works with students and community members to design and install bricolage murals at schools, parks, underpasses and other public spaces.

Bricolage murals incorporate tile and mirror mosaic, photos, sculpture, and painting to create dynamic, durable public art.

When volunteers arrive, a Green Star Movement Project Manager will lead an introduction on the project and then provide training for the day's tasks. Tasks may include nipping/placing tile or mixing/applying grout. No experience is necessary!

Volunteers may work alongside youth participants depending on the school and students' schedules.



Volunteers are encouraged to bring water and a snack if they desire. Please leave cigarettes and other smoking equipment at home.

Volunteers should wear comfortable clothes they don't mind getting dirty. Closed-toe shoes are required. Sunglasses and sunscreen are recommended!


Volunteers may be working on scaffolds or ladders. Volunteers should conduct themselves in a way that promotes the safety of themselves and others. Report any personal injury that occurs while volunteering to a staff member. Volunteers are covered under the organization's insurance for injury to themselves.
